Ranked Choice Voting App

RCV for Colorado demonstrates Ranked Choice Voting by conducting real elections for organizations and just-for-fun elections as voter education at events. The graphic display of our app is based on best practices developed by the Center for Civic Design.

Voter education events serve to provide a lived experience of RCV which inoculates voters to misinformation.

Voting portion of the event:

Because Colorado uses paper ballots, RCV for Colorado prepares voters by also using paper ballots.


Ballot design and instructions are based on those recommended for use in Colorado by a December 2017 study conducted in Denver by Center for Civic Design.


The ballot data entry is designed for ease of use by the event volunteer - the selections in the app visually match the markings on the paper ballot.

One person does data entry while another is giving a presentation about RCV. The results are routinely ready before the end of the presentation, so that they may be given to the audience. This impresses upon the audience that RCV is not theoretical.

Dirty Harry in Dirty Harry


The tally display sorts the candidates in descending order based on first-choice votes. This makes it easier to see which candidate is being eliminated. A modification made to this display is that it indicates the voter's first-choice preference. This makes it easier for participants to see where their individual vote is in the process. When just-for-fun elections are used by restaurants and breweries, it helps the proprietor use the results as a minimarket study. They can see cross-over appeal between different flavor profiles.

Tally display portion of the event:

The presenter narrates the display of the tally:


In Round 1, we see that Dirty Harry (Clint Eastwood) has the lead - but no candidate has a majority of 1st choices. The candidate with the fewest 1st choices is Dutch (Arnold Schwartzenegger), so he will be eliminated for Round 2.


In Round 2, we see that ballots cast for Dutch were transferred to those voter's 2nd choices - Rambo and Dirty Harry. Now the candidate with the fewest ballots is Rambo (Sylvester Stalone), who will be eliminated for Round 3. (Sorry, Rambo.)

In Round 3, the Rambo ballots go to their next choice - Dirty Harry and John McClane. Mathayus didn't appeal to the Rambo voters, so he lost his chance to catch up. Now the candidate with the fewest ballots is Mathayus, who will be eliminated for Round 4.



In Round 4, John McClane of Die Hard takes it with the support of the Mathayus fans! There is a consensus that if the group wants to watch a movie - John McClane is the Action Hero most in demand.

Of note: The display also track ballots that are no longer active because their last voted preference was eliminated. In the live demonstration, we do not bring this up unless someone broaches the topic.
